Program:	Vision 20/20 Reintegration Strategic Plan
Problem Statement:	Data from the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) shows that over 30% of individuals released from incarceration in Los Angeles County will return within 3 years.
Goal:	To reduce the recidivism rate of formerly incarcerated individuals in Los Angeles County.
	Objectives: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Create pathways to self-sufficiency <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Assumption – incarceration creates barriers that limit options and make it difficult not to re-offend 2. Increase mental health and substance abuse outcomes <ol style="list-style-type: none"> b. Assumption – formerly incarcerated individuals experience higher rates of trauma; mental health and substance abuse disorders increase likelihood of recidivism 3. Align and strengthen community resources <ol style="list-style-type: none"> c. Assumption – service gaps and community health are indicating factors in cycles of recidivism
